

Year	Contents
1897	Founded as Kyoto Imperial University. The College of Science and Engineering was established.
1899	Colleges of Law and Medicine were established. The University Library and the University Hospital were established.
1906	The College of Letters was established.
1914	The College of Science and Engineering was divided into two, the College of Science and the College of Engineering.
1919	Colleges were reorganized into five faculties under the new University Ordinance. The Faculty of Economics was established.
1923	The Faculty of Agriculture was established.

1953	Graduate courses under the new system were opened. The Yukawa Institute for Theoretical Physics was established.
1954	The Branch School was renamed the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
1956	The Institute for Virus Research was established.
1960	The Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences was established.
1962	The Institute of Economic Research was established.
1963	The Research Institute for Mathematical Sciences and the Research Reactor Institute were established.
1965	The Center for Southeast Asian Studies was established.
1966	The Center for Student Health was established.
1967	The Primate Research Institute was established.
1969	The Data Processing Center was established.

2002	The Graduate School of Global Environmental Studies was established. The Research Center for Low Temperature and Materials Sciences and the Fukui Institute for Fundamental Chemistry were established.
2003	The Research Center for Sports Science was closed. The Seto Marine Biological Laboratory, University Forest, Subtropical Plant Institute and Fisheries Research Station were merged into the Field Science Education and Research Center. The Research Center for Higher Education was reorganized and renamed the Center for the Promotion of Excellence in Higher Education. The Institute for the Promotion of Excellence in Higher Education and the Law School were established. The College of Medical Technology was merged into the Graduate School of Medicine.
2004	Kyoto University incorporated in accordance with the National University Corporation Law.
	The Wood Research Institute and Radio Science Center for Space and Atmosphere were unified as the Research Institute for Sustainable Humanosphere. The Center for Southeast Asian Studies was given Institute status. The Center for Molecular Biology and Genetics and the Center for Data Collection and Analysis were closed.
2005	The Organization for the Promotion of International Relations, Environment, Safety, and Health Organization, International Innovation Organization, Institute for Information Management and Communication, and Library Network were established. The International Innovation Center was reorganized and renamed the Innovative Collaboration Center. The Institute for Integrated Cell-Material Sciences was established.

Consolidated Revenues and Expenses in Net Assets








### Researchers Coming from Abroad (April 2006-March 2007)





#### **UNIVERSITY FACILITIES**

#### INTERNATIONAL HOUSES

In order to facilitate international education and research exchanges, Kyoto University has established three International Houses: housing facilities for students and researchers from overseas.

The International Houses are not simply housing facilities; they also serve as sites for interaction and exchange between the international students and researchers, university associates and the people of Kyoto.

The three Kyoto University International Houses are located in Shugakuin, Uji, and Ohbaku.

#### KYOTO UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

The Kyoto University Library was established over 100 years ago in 1899. The library is continually expanding its collection, which currently stands at approximately 880,000 books and 24,500 periodicals. In addition to regular printed material, the library also acquires other types of publications and media such as e-journals, data bases and audiovisual materials (available in the Media Commons), ensuring that it continues to be an up-to-date store of academic knowledge. Various services are also offered online

(The total collection of all libraries on Kyoto University's campuses, including faculty and departmental libraries, amounts to 6,228,000 books and 89,000 periodicals).

#### **UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL**

Kyoto University Hospital was established in 1899 as a part of Kyoto Imperial University. With the incorporation of the Chest Diseases Research Institute in April of 1998, the University Hospital became a general hospital with multiple departments, offering top-level medical services to people in and around Kyoto. The hospital currently has 1,182 beds. As of 2006, inpatients number approximately 371,000 and outpatients approximately 602,000.

In April 2001, the Translational Research Center was established to undertake research into fundamental transplants in humans. In January 2003, the Post Graduate Clinical Education Center was established for medical trainees to broaden their understanding of primary medical care, and to acquire and develop a holistic attitude towards the treatment of patients.

In April 2005, the Post Graduate Clinical Education Center became the Integrated Clinical Education Center, a center which trains and educates not only clinicians and dental practitioners, but also nurses, pharmacists and other medical professionals.

The hospital began a program of living-donor liver transplantations in 1990. As of June 2004, over 1000 living-donor liver transplantations have been performed, setting a world record. About 40% of all such transplantation operations in Japan have been carried out at Kyoto University Hospital, making it a world leading facility in that field.




